

SUZAN QUILTS... Yet Another 12 Days of Christmas Day 5



Angel Block

Cutting

Background fabric

Cut 1 square 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".

Petal fabric

Cut 1 strip 2" x 8".

Cut 6 Tiny Dresden petals with Day 2

Tiny Dresden template, or use Suzn

Quilts' Tiny Dresden template #216.

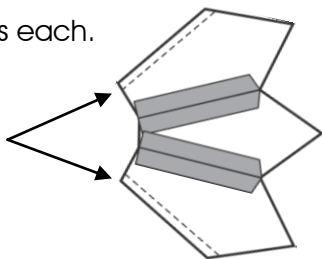
Make & Appliqué The Angel

Follow Day 2 Tiny Dresden Plate instructions to **Sew The Tiny Dresden Petals**, to make 6 petals.

Sew 2 petals together then sew 1 more petal to the pair, press.

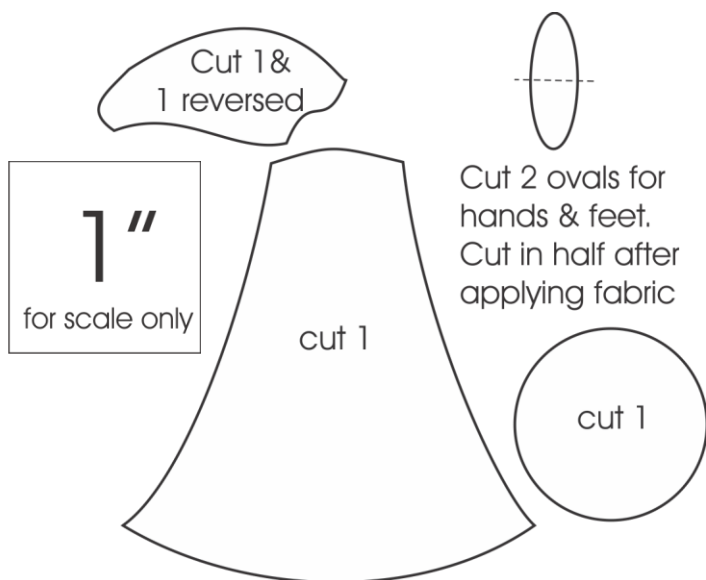
Make 2 sets with 3 petals each.

Fold under 1/4" seam allowance & glue w/ Roxanne™ Glue-Baste-it, on outside petals to conceal raw edges.



Trace templates below onto freezer paper. Press wax side of freezer paper templates to wrong side of fabrics & cut out with 1/4" seam allowance. Glue seam allowance to paper side of templates w/ Roxanne glue. Appliquick Bars make this task much easier!

Cut each flesh oval as shown by dashed line, making two hands & two feet.

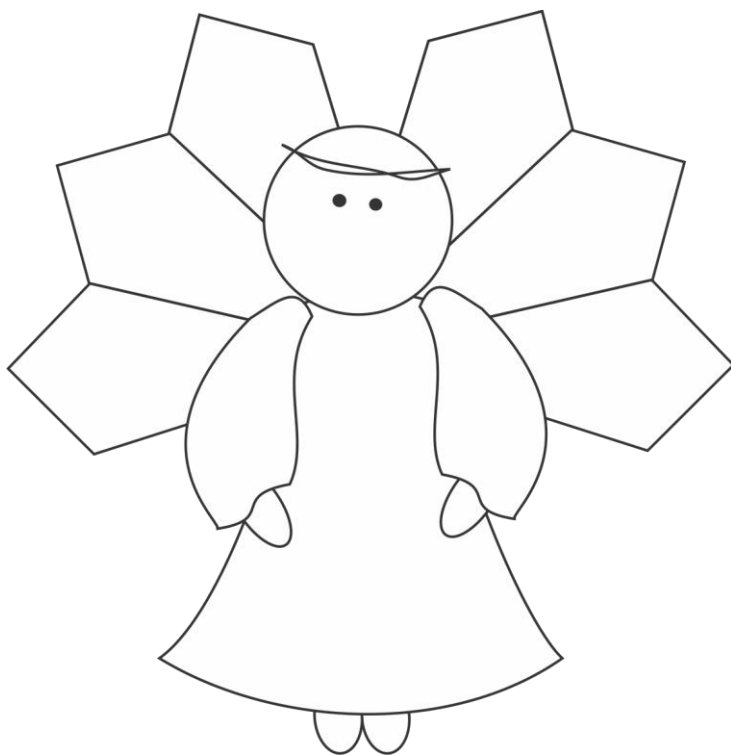


Using the full size illustration below, assemble & glue angel together. Glue edges of angel to background fabric, then stitch.

Model was machine stitched with tiny blind hem stitch with matching thread on the flesh pieces & buttonhole stitched with contrasting taupe color thread on the gown & wings.

I didn't remove paper templates because of dark fabric shadowing.

If you prefer to remove paper templates, carefully cut slits in bkgd. fabric behind pieces. Dampen back side of paper. Let rest a few minutes then remove paper templates. A slight pull diagonally on the block will release the templates.



Mark, then stitch the angel's eyes & halo.

Block should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".
Make 1 angel block.
